**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing September 9 each year as Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders**  
2 **Awareness Day."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 44.12.074. Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders Awareness Day.** Fetal  
6 Alcohol Spectrum Disorders Awareness Day is established on September 9 of each  
7 year to promote awareness of the fact that there is no known safe level of alcohol  
8 consumption during pregnancy, to promote awareness of the effects of prenatal  
9 exposure to alcohol, to increase identification of children with fetal alcohol spectrum  
10 disorders, and to improve the lives of those affected by fetal alcohol spectrum  
11 disorders.
